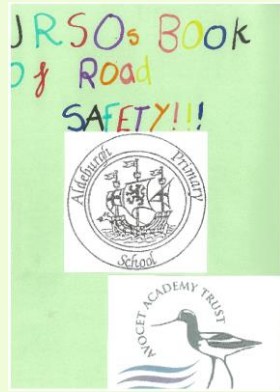

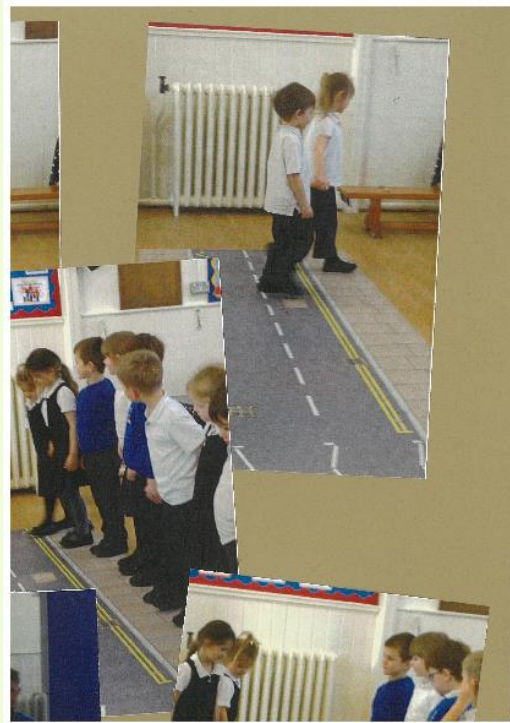


Abbots Green identified an issue in their car park and worked to resolve it. They also ran many competitions through the year...

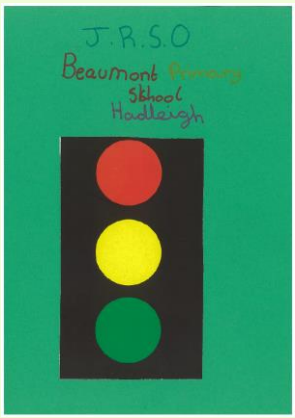

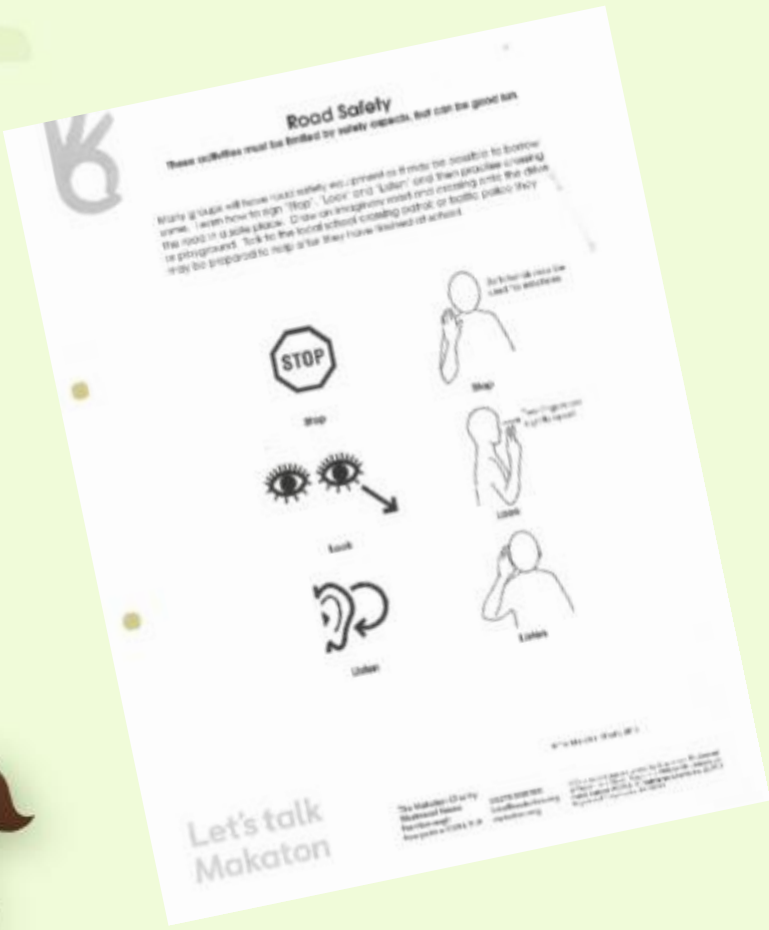

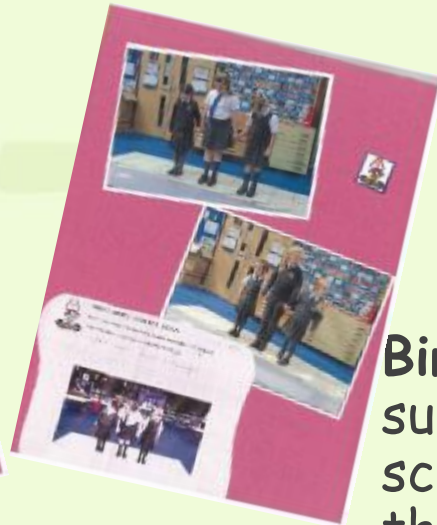
Solution
